Why you (yes, you!) should propose a workshop

Proposing a workshop will let you meet research collaborators and convince others that your research agenda is important and impactful. Consider starting a workshop that:

- Sparks discussion and dissent about a controversial idea
- Explores new ideas for emerging fields and technologies
- Solicits feedback for a white paper for government/industry leaders and policymakers
- Fosters the next generation of microsystems researchers (grad student, early career)

What topic(s) you might want to propose

We're looking for a wide range of great ideas, and we don't want to limit your creativity. To get your brainstorming started, maybe you want to consider the roles or impacts of:

- **Chips Act:** impact, ramifications, opportunities
- **MEMS in daily life:** a vision for 2035
- **TinyML:** not just for embedded devices anymore

What support you'll receive for your workshop

Organizers for selected workshops will receive a meeting room, on-site AV and admin support, and a super cool ribbon to put on their nametag.

How to submit your workshop proposal

Please send a PDF (≤ 2 pages) with the below information via email to sundayworkshops@hh2024.org by **December 21, 2023**. The selected workshops will be notified on January 3, 2024.

- **Workshop title, organizers, affiliations, and emails**
- **Workshop length** (i.e., full day or half day)
- **Workshop abstract (<150 words)** (Note: This abstract will be used to attract potential participants during the registration process.)
- **Who is your target audience for the workshop?** (e.g., early career, researchers in X, industry, people who use SEM/microfab process/advanced tool)
- **Do you have plans to advertise or otherwise let your participants know about the workshop?**
- **What activities will your workshop include?** (e.g., lightning talks, invited speakers, tutorials)
- **What speakers, if any, will you invite to the workshop?**
- **What day-of and AV support do you imagine you'd need during the workshop?**
- **Will you generate any deliverables as a result of the workshop?**
- **Please include a brief schedule of activities between 10 AM – 12 PM and 1-3 PM**
